The Genoa City Police Department handled 204 calls for service during July 2013 versus 294 calls for service in 2012. GCPD collected \$66,361.10 in fines for July 2013 VS July 2012 \$19,189.66 was collected.

Informational Items:

Country Thunder 2013 Overall After Action Report

Genoa City made a larger concentrated effort this year versus past years. This decision was based on my observation last year where Genoa City PD officers located two highly intoxicated and incapacitated young men face down in a mud puddle. Our goal was to engage in visitor oriented policing and to curb the binge drinking that occurs in our jurisdiction and to head off overflow problems into the Village which has occurred in the years past. The statistics listed above show the hard work of four officers working the camp grounds, two officers in the command

post and the Intern assisting keeping up on data entry. I was on site during the majority of the event which we patrolled about 12 hours per day. We also had Sgt Sireno and Ofc Humphreys assigned to the Village on a 12 hour rotation with me filling the gaps on one night. All members of the Genoa City PD were on board minus one part time officer due to commitments at his full time department. Administrative assistant Osborn came in to keep up on bond posters a few hours each day throughout the weekend. Trustees Boxer and Traskaski also assisted in volunteering at the command post with set up, operations, locating equipment and assisting watching impaired individuals until sober responsible persons could arrive and sign for them. Also Shannon Sperandeo came out and helped with the flow of visitors to our Village. Additional thanks to Superintendent Schiller for his assistant with Public Works employee Scott Klaubunde who without hesitation assisted in set up and tear down and transporting of equipment.

Also I will be sending a letter of thanks to Chief Steve Olson from Fontana PD for his assistance in loaning of a portable generator and Army Tent.
